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## About Us

The Murrumburrah-Harden Health Service is a 33 bed facility with 13 acute care beds and 20 residential aged care beds. Murrumburrah-Harden Health Service provides and a 24 hour Accident and Emergency Department, which is equipped with telehealth cameras to connect the team in Harden with specialists through the Critical Care Advisory Service.

A range of community nursing and allied health services are also available.

## Location

Murrumburrah-Harden is a township in Hilltops Council located in southwest slopes region of New South Wales.

Murrumburrah-Harden is an agricultural area with both the rich local soils and the cool, dry climate being ideal for wheat, oats, canola, lupins, mustard oil seed and cold climate fruits including nashi pears, cherries, strawberries, peaches, nectarines, prunes and apricots. The local economy is driven by agriculture with both towns operating as service centres for the surrounding district which also includes large grain-storage silos, sheep, cattle, horse studs and vineyards.

Murrumburrah-Harden lies about 2 hours northwest of Canberra, and 2 hours northeast of Wagga Wagga and is about 4 ½ hours drive to Sydney.
